CARE Band/Key Chain

Instruction Booklet

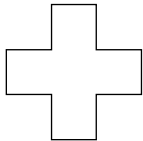
As a valued patient of WellMed, we present you with your personal medical CARE band or CARE key chain. This portable device is a link to your secured Electronic Medical Record (EMR)/medical summary. Our goal is to offer patients the peace of mind knowing their medical records will be easily accessible in case of an emergency or if other medical measures are necessary.

Your medical summary is a read-only document and located on a secured web page. Be sure to keep it visible and on your person at all times.

Only WellMed patients enrolled in SecureHorizons[®] and Evercare[®] health insurance plans will receive a CARE band or key chain. These are a part of the value-added services you'll receive on behalf of your doctor and WellMed Medical Group.

IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY

Your band or key chain is designed to provide emergency responders with as much medical history as possible. Emergency



responders will need internet access to retrieve your information via a secured web page connection.

GETTING STARTED

Upon receipt, your physician's office staff will install a secured link to your medical record web page. The office staff will verify your general information and medical insurance to ensure it is correct prior to updating the band or key chain. You will not have to do anything except keep the band or key chain with you.

DO NOT LOSE

Treat your CARE band or key chain as you would your driver's license. The port (metal part) is a direct link to your medical records through a secured web page connection. If you do lose your band or key chain, please call **(210) 615-WELL (9355)** to have it disabled.

UPDATING

Updating is automatic and available immediately after your records are revised by the physician's office.

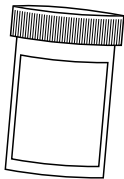


INFORMATION INCLUDED

The items on your medical summary include:

- Patient's general information
- Doctor information
- Insurance information
- Benefits
- Specialist information
- Most recent WellMed medical records

- Lab results from the past 12 months
- Allergies
- Immunizations
- Prescriptions prescribed
- Patient problem list
- Notice of Last Will and Testament and/or Living Will on file (if available)



VIEWING YOUR MEDICAL SUMMARY

To view your read-only medical summary, place the CARE band or key chain into your computer via the metal USB port. For some computers, this new drive will open automatically. Once the drive opens, click on the folder or WellMed icon to open your file.

If it does not open automatically, go to view, file and locate the drive. Once the drive opens, click the folder or WellMed icon to view your summary. Only your WellMed physician or staff can make changes to this file through our Electronic Medical Records. If you need to make any change, please contact your clinic.

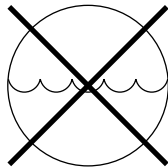


CLEANING

If the band or key chain gets dirty, place a small amount of soap on a damp cloth and gently wipe it. Be careful to **NOT** get the port (metal part) wet. Wipe off with a dry towel. The band and key chain are designed to withstand some dust and dirt without affecting its function.

DO NOT SUBMERGE IN WATER

The CARE band and key chain are designed to be protected if water is dripped on it. However, it is not watertight. Please do not submerge in water and be sure to remove before bathing or swimming.
