## **WellMed Expands Support Services Center To 52,000 Square Feet In Northwest San Antonio**

**Additional Space To Be Occupied By End Of January 2010**

**San Antonio, TX** – WellMed Medical Management has signed a lease agreement that expands its support services central hub to more than 52,000 square feet in Northwest San Antonio.

WellMed has leased an additional 14,700 square feet of office space at 6000 Northwest Parkway in the University Park Tech Center II. The building, near UTSA and just north of the San Antonio Medical Center, is owned by Dallas-based commercial property management firm Trinity Interests. Financial terms were not disclosed.

The space is adjacent to 5800 Northwest Parkway, where WellMed houses several support departments such as utilization management, case management, customer service and IT in 38,000 square feet. Claims, contract administration and credentialing will move into the new space next door by the end of January 2010, company officials said.

The departments support several WellMed subsidiaries, including WellMed Medical Group (medical clinics in Texas and Florida); HealthRight (award-winning disease management program) and Physicians Health Choice (Medicare Advantage HMO provider in Texas, New Mexico, Arkansas and Florida).
